

TERMS OF ENTRY:

- Applications are only accepted electronically according to the parameters provided below.
- Artists may submit 1 recent piece (completed in the last 2 yrs). Open to all artists over 18.
- Work previously shown at any ArtWorks or QEPCCC venue is not eligible for entry.
- Submissions can include paintings in any medium; drawings; mixed-media; encaustic; hand-pulled prints; fibre art, photography and sculpture (free standing and 2D). One image for 2D works, 2 images from different angles can be submitted for 3D works.
- All art must be exhibition ready. Professional framing, mounting hardware securely attached to the frame. ArtWorks will not be responsible for damage caused by failed hanging equipment. Faulty or poor wiring, sawtooth or clip hangers, wet paint, nudity or controversial subject matter, work created with assistance, reproductions, copies & giclees will not be accepted.
- No substitutions. Only the work accepted by the jurors will be included in the show. Accepted work may not be withdrawn from the show. Entries are non-refundable.
- ArtWorks fully insures accepted work while at QEPCCC during the exhibition.
- Artists receive 80% of all works sold and winners receive prizes.

Jurying of entries will take place on March 21, 2021, via electronic submissions only. Judges' decisions are final.
